<p>- Died at age 85 when his private plane, a Cessna 172, which he was piloting alone, crashed near his home in Hershey, PA. The crash occurred during a snow squall accompanied by fog Dec. 2, 1983.</p> <p>- At about 2 PM the same day Jim McLallen (husband of Fred's niece Ethel Hite), who lived in Chadds Ford, PA about 70 miles SE of Hershey, cancelled his plans to fly his Cessna 172 as the weather front was already coming through on its way to Hershey (source: a hand written note by Ethel on a copy of The Daily News from 12/5/83).</p>
