<p>Revolutionary War - served three years in the Continental Army, in the 13th and 2nd Pennsylvania Regiments commanded by Colonel Walter Stewart, under Brigadier General Anthony Wayne. Honorably discharged January 14, 1781; wintered at Valley Forge 1778; was in the Battle of Monmouth and others.- Spent his early years in his father's mill and learned the milling trade which he followed at different places down the river. - (source "Panorama..." page 192)</p> <p>- One of the early ordained Fathers of the German Reformed Church of America (now the United Church of Christ) - (source: "Panorama..." page 132).</p> <p>- Both John and Catharine are buried at Schafferville Cemetery, Huntingdon Co., close to Water Street</p> <p>1778-1781 - Revolutionary War Soldier - served 3 years in the Continental Army (Pg 192) 1801-1804 - Was a preacher at the Buffalo Valley German Reformed Church (Dreisbach's)</p>
